





Perkasie's 20th annual Fall Festival will take place from 12pm-4pm on Sunday, October 3rd, 2021. The Festival takes place in both the town center, and in Menlo Park. The event sites are linked by a free bus, or visitors can enjoy the short walk between the two locations. Perkasie's historic Carousel is open for the day.



The theme of this year's event is "Sweet Treats". Visitors are invited to a pie eating contest, bobbing for apples, candy corn hole toss, sweet tasting bakery treats and more.

As every year, families will find lots of free fun at Menlo Park, including a petting zoo, balloon twisting, face painting, and (weather permitting) the Boing

gymnastics Tumble Track and pony rides (small fee). Free fall-themed crafts are under one park pavilion, and scarecrow decorating is under the other. Families are welcome to build and enter a scarecrow in this popular contest (one per family please, while supplies last, or bring your own).

Perkasie's town center plays host to lots of free activities, including tractor rides, a large outdoor games area, a massive "Big Red Baller" inflatable and the Revivals Block Party. Pumpkin decorating and other free attractions are on N.7th St.The wing eating contest at 2:30pm is followed by the ever-popular pie eating contest at 3:15pm. Musical entertainment is provided by the Bucks County Folk Song Society, Mudfroot and the Back Porch Jug Band. Visitors to the town center can enter to win large raffle baskets with prizes generously donated by local businesses. All this, plus tons of food, and a large craft and vendor fair. Town center stores and eateries are open with shopping and dining specials.



A Message From The Public Works Department

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

Leaf collection will begin mid-October and continue through November, weather permitting. Please look for confirmed dates on the Borough's website and social media. Rake leaves into the street along the curb line without blocking or clogging storm drains. Please keep vehicles away from areas where leaves are piled.

Leaves will be picked up when scheduling allows. There are no set collection days for areas of the Borough. The Public Works crew will follow a specific route and do so cyclically.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Christmas trees (without wire) are picked up along with recyclables during the first three weeks of January. Wreaths with or without wire will be collected with refuse. Live-balled Christmas trees may be donated for planting in Borough parks.

RECYCLING CENTER HOURS

Monday through Friday: 7:30 am - 8:30 pm

Saturdays: 7:30 am - 4:00 pm It is closed Sundays and most holidays.

The Borough Recycling Center, located behind the Perkasie Police Department, at 311 South 9th Street, is for the convenience of Borough Residents ONLY. Perkasie Borough staff may ask for identification when you use the Center. There are signs indicating where recyclable materials are to be placed. No plastic bags, please. Combine glass, aluminum, tin and plastic (PDE #1-7) containers in the dumpsters that are marked as such and that have metal stairs. Combine newspaper and cardboard and place in the trailer. Trash and bulky items are not accepted at the Recycling Center.



Here are some environmentally friendly tips for keeping your lawn and garden healthy this fall:

- Dispose of leaf litter and yard waste in a compost pile, never in the street or stream! You can shred yard waste to use as mulch or fertilizer for your yard and garden.
 Or, check with you municipality for yard waste collection opportunities.
- 2) Apply herbicides and fertilizers sparingly and never before it rains. Try spot treating for weeds or, better yet, pull them by hand! If you have to use herbicides or fertilizers on your lawn, make sure to always follow the instructions and sweep up anything that falls on hard surfaces.
- 3) Add native plants to your yard. Now through Thanksgiving can be the best time to put native plants in the ground. Many plants go dormant in the fall and winter and will not require much maintenance to survive until spring. Native plants aid in the infiltration of stormwater and provide important food and habitat for wildlife.



A Message From The Perkasie Borough Police Department

The Perkasie Borough Police Department provides full-time police services to the residents of Perkasie and Sellersville Boroughs and is staffed by eighteen full-time police officers and two administrative staff members.

In addition to patrolling our community and responding to calls for service the police department offers fingerprinting services for employment and vacation checks of your residence. We also have a car seat safety technician who can assist in installing car seats for infants and young children by contacting our administrative office during regular business hours at 215-257-6876. The department also offers a prescription drug drop take-back box in the lobby of our police headquarters.

As winter weather driving season is approaching AAA offers the following tips for driving in winter weather;

- Watch the traffic ahead of you. Slow down immediately but again, moderately at the sight of brake lights, skidding vehicles or emergency lights.
- **Intersections can be especially slippery** as ice thaws from the heat of idling vehicles. "Water on top of ice is a very dangerous situation," Paul said.
- Lay off the cruise control. Summer will be here soon enough.
- **Avoid unnecessary lane changes.** Changing lanes increases your chances of hitting ice between lanes, which could cause a loss of traction and, potentially, a crash.
- **Don't power up snow-covered hills.** It's not easy for a vehicle to climb an icy road. If you're stuck and you hit the gas, you may just spin your tires. If you must climb such an incline, try to get a little momentum going and let that carry you up. When you come to the crest, slow down and proceed cautiously, and slowly, downhill.
- Don't try to brake on ice if you can avoid it. If you're approaching an area and you spot ice, apply your brakes on clear pavement to reduce speed. "Black ice, sometimes referred to as flash ice, can catch even an experienced driver by surprise," Paul said. "Black ice happens when a thin layer of moisture freezes on the roadway, and it can be very dangerous."
- If you have anti-lock brakes, you can press hard on the pedal. It might vibrate a bit, but that's normal. Vehicles with anti-lock brake systems allow drivers to brake and steer at the same time, possibly in avoidance of a collision.
- **Do not send or read text messages, or engage in other distracting behavior.** That's a critically important piece of advice for winter, or summer, or really any day of any year ever.





A Message From The Electric Department

BRUSH COLLECTION PROGRAM

Brush clippings will be picked up by Borough crews on the **FIRST WEDNESDAY** of each month as part of the scheduled brush collection. However, collection of brush clippings will be **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.** If you have brush clippings to be picked up, then you should inform the Borough Office by phone 48 hours in advance of the scheduled collection time. Brush clippings shall be bundled with string or twine and shall not exceed ten (10) feet in length and {'one and one-half (1-1/2) feet in diameter. Smaller bundles should be bound with string or twine. Please take notice that logs are accepted up to 8" in diameter, no lumber is accepted in your brush piles, roots are not accepted for chipping, the amount of acceptable brush per month is a small chest freezer size amount, and no containers of brush will be accepted for chipping. Brush in containers is considered yard waste and can be dropped off on the first Saturday of the month from 7:30 am until 3:00 pm behind the Publics Works Building.

- Motorized vehicles, including dirt bikes and ATVs are not permitted in Borough Parks
- Cyclists **must yield** to pedestrians on all park trails
- No smoking, alcohol, or illegal substances are permitted in the parks
- **No dumping.** Leaves, trees, limbs, trimmings and other yard waste may be dropped off at the Borough Recycling Center the first Saturday of the Month
- Commemorative benches and tables honoring friends, family, pets and others are available for placement in any Borough Park. For more information please visit www.PerkasieRec.com
- **Dogs must be on a leash.** If you see a dog running loose, please call the Police.
- Pet owners are required to **clean up after their animals,** not only in Borough Parks, but on all public and private property throughout the Borough or face the possibility of a fine
