



2023 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

After review with the Borough Manager, Engineer, and Public Works the following list of roads have been targeting for improvements in 2023.

- Union Street entire road
- Highland Drive entire road
- 8th Street from Chestnut Street to Market Street
- Buttonwood Street from 7th Street to 5th Street
- Arthur Avenue entire road
- Elm Avenue from 5th Street to 6th Street
- Meadow Lane entire road within Borough
- Pine Street from 8th Street to 9th Street
- S. 8th Street from Pine Street to Park Avenue
- Cedar Avenue from 4th Street to 5th Street
- Market Street Alley entire road






Every 2-3 years our engineers conduct a Roadway Condition Survey. Each survey provides us with a current assessment of the existing roadway conditions and recommendations for future roadway repair projects. We use the survey report to prioritize annual roadway repairs and to efficiently allocate funding.

The survey report includes a 5-15 year reconstruction plan, which helps us project future budgets for roads, the concrete program, stormwater improvements etc. This plan is revised every 2-3 years with each new survey, and we also conduct field surveys more frequently, as weather and other factors can create new and unforeseen priorities. A number of roads lie within the Borough but are owned by the state and maintained by PennDOT (see below); the Roadway Condition Survey does not examine or report on State roads.

2023 Road Improvement Program continued from cover

Pavement conditions on Borough-owned roads are rated using a methodology based on the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Guide for Design of Pavement Structures. According to this scale, the lower the rating, the better the road condition; a higher rating means the road is more in need of repair.

The 5-15 year reconstruction plan indicates that ALL our roads rated as 4.5 and 5 will be repaired by the year 2025. Perkasie Borough Council recently increased taxes by 3 mils and it is designated strictly for roads. It will allow the Borough to mill and pave more of its most vulnerable roads each year. The sooner we get all of the roads milled and paved we can start focusing on a regular maintenance plan each year in order to increase the life of the road and keep them safe, instead of waiting until they deteriorate and become and even bigger expense.

As a reminder property owners are responsible for the upkeep and repairs of sidewalks and curbs. Residents and businesses on roads scheduled for repair are subject to sidewalk inspections and will be notified if repairs are required before the roadway is repaired.

Public Works

The Borough Recycling Center, located behind the Perkasie Police Department, at 311 South 9th Street, is for the convenience of Borough Residents ONLY.

Hours are Monday through Friday 7:30am-8:30pm and Saturdays 7:30am-4:00pm. As a reminder it is CLOSED Sundays and most holidays. Perkasie Borough staff may ask for identification when you use the Center.

There are signs indicating where recyclable materials are to be placed. No plastic bags, please. Combine glass, aluminum, tin and plastic (PDE #1-7) containers in the dumpsters that are marked as such and that have metal stairs. Combine newspaper and cardboard and place in the recycling shed at the rear of the center. Trash and bulky items are not accepted at the Recycling Center.



Stormwater Pollution Prevention Tips

Clean-up

Collect and dispose of any trash that might have blown into your yard over the winter. Mulch or compost leaves and garden cuttings from the fall so that they don't get washed into local streams.

Fertilize Carefully

Look for slow release nitrogen fertilizer since it is less likely to harm water quality. Several small fertilizer applications spread out over the growing season is better than one large application. Never apply fertilizer before it rains!

Caring for Your Yard this Spring

Spring is here and with it comes warmer weather, rain and lots of yard work! Before you head outside to tackle your latest project, remember that what you do to your yard has a direct impact on the local environment. Luckily, there are lots of small steps that you can take as a homeowner to make your yard more eco-friendly!

Consider these tips to help you reduce stormwater pollution and provide valuable habitat for local wildlife on your property.

Plant Natives!

Spring is a great time to plant native trees, shrubs and perennials! Native PA species require less maintenance, are more beneficial for wildlife and absorb more stormwater than non-natives.

Mow Sharp and High

A sharp mower blade cuts grass cleanly which improves turf health. Set your mower deck to 2.5 inches or more to help reduce stormwater runoff and shade out weeds. Where possible, consider converting a section of your lawn to a native garden.

Message from Perkasie Electric Department

Perkasie is unique among Pennsylvania municipalities. We are one of only 35 communities to own and operate our own electric utility for the benefit of the community.



While public power utilities offer many benefits, here are five that are important to talk about.

1. COMMUNITY OWNED

Our customers are our friends and neighbors. We provide local jobs and support the local economy. Our community's citizens have a voice in making decisions for the utility.

2. NOT FOR PROFIT

Surplus revenues don't go to outside shareholders — they stay in the community. Revenues are invested in system improvements, shared with the local government, or offset electric rate increases. On average, public power utilities pay 5.6 percent of electric operating revenues back to the community — through taxes, fees, and special services. Compared to private utilities, public power gives 27 percent more back to the community.

3. AFFORDABLE

Homes powered by public power utilities pay nearly 10 percent less than homes powered by investor-owned companies. Businesses that get electricity from public power utilities also pay less.


4. RELIABLE

Customers of public power utilities lose power less often. Customers of a public power utility are on average without power for just 74 minutes a year, compared to customers of private utilities that lose power for an average 142 minutes a year — provided there are no major adverse events.

5. RESPONSIVE

As a public power utility, we deliver what the community wants. We are committed to the highest level of customer service. We support local economic development, demonstrate environmental stewardship, and invest back in the community.

The Police Department

The Perkasie Borough Police Department Provides full-primary police services to Perkasie and Sellersville Boroughs twenty-four hours a day. The police department is staffed by nineteen full-time police officers which includes two detectives that are supervised by an administrative Sergeant.

The police department administrative office is staffed by two civilian employees, (administrative assistant and a police secretary) Monday through Friday from 8;30 am to 4:30 pm excluding recognized holidays. The department non-emergency number is 215-257-6876. For emergencies, please dial 911.

The Perkasie Police Department is happy to report that Officer Sean Jeffries graduated from the Montgomery County Municipal Police Academy in December of 2022 and was the class valedictorian and was provided with the opportunity to be the academy cadet who gave the class commencement speech.

As was reported in the fall newsletter we also look forward to Officer Alexander Groves graduating from Temple University Police Department in March of 2023 and starting his field training.

The Police Department in conjunction with the Perkasie Borough Civil Service Commission has started the process to promote a Patrol Sergeant after Sergeant Jim Rothrock retired in June of 2022. The promotional process entails a rigorous written exam and an oral interview. Currently, six officers have applied to take the written examination as the first step in the process.



SPRINGTIME DRIVING TIPS

8 Tips to Pedestrian Safety


- 1. Look out for pedestrians everywhere, at all times.
- 2. Use extra caution when driving in hard-to-see conditions, such as nighttime or bad weather.
- 3. Slow down and be prepared to stop when turning or otherwise entering a crosswalk.
- 4. Yield to pedestrians in crosswalks and stop well back from the crosswalk to give other vehicles an opportunity to see the crossing pedestrians so they can stop too.
- 5. Never pass vehicles stopped at a crosswalk. There may be people crossing where you can't see.
- 6. Never drive under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.
- 7. Follow the speed limit, especially around people on the street, in school zones and in neighborhoods where children are present.
- 8. Be extra cautious when backing up and look for pedestrians.

The Perkasie Borough Police Department maintains a staff of nineteen full-time police officers serving the residents of Perkasie and Sellersville Boroughs. Officers are on duty twenty-four hours a day seven days a week. Office hours with administrative staff present are Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm excluding holidays. 

2022 Budget Highlights

Upgrades and improvements were made to our Recycling Center with grant funds from the Pennsylvania Act 101, Section 902 Recycling Program. The Borough provided a 10% match from its Refuse Fund. The total grant award was \$305,765, with a required match of \$40,647. The new compactor machine will allow the Borough's Public Works crew to bale all paper products, reducing the Borough's costs associated with hauling the material and also increasing the rebate for the product.

The resurfacing of the tennis and pickle ball courts at Kulp Park were completed in 2022. The project cost was \$274,792. We were able to utilize revenue from land development Impact Fees to help offset the cost of this project. Impact fees contributed \$125,000 towards the project total with an additional \$149,792 from the Borough's Capital fund. The Park and Recreation Impact Fee was approved in 2014 to require all new land development projects to contribute a maximum of \$1,500 per dwelling unit to the fund.

In 2022 the Borough was granted an extension for its Multimodal Grant Award which was used for the pocket park and trail through the Trolley Tunnel. The total grant award was \$283,171, with a required match of \$104,907. The Borough provided the match from its Capital Fund.

The Lenape Park Amphitheater & Restroom project was completed in 2022 thanks to the donation of the amphitheater building from Oldecastle Infrastructure. The accessible ramp & railings on the amphitheater, along with the restroom facility was done in conjunction with the donation. 75% of the funding for that part of the project came from the Bucks County Open Space Grant (\$332,217). The Borough provided a 25% match from its Capital Fund (\$110,758).

The 3 mill increase in real estate taxes for the dedicated road program allowed the Borough to mill and pave 10 roads in 2022 for a total project cost of \$744,547. Of that total, \$266,000 from the new road tax, \$255,000 PA State Liquid Fuels, and \$223,547 from the Borough's Capital fund. The dedicated road program will make it possible for the Borough to continue with repairing the most vulnerable roads. We will be able to focus on a regular maintenance plan to preserve the quality of the roads. This will help to avoid more expensive road work and make the roads safer.

Looking forward into 2023

The Borough Electric Department started rolling out the electric meter replacement program. Notices are being sent out to customers to provide detailed information and what you can expect. This information can also be found on the Borough's website.

2023 is underway and we continue to strive to provide the best service to our residents. The adopted budget for 2023 is 2.4% less than the 2022 budget. The property tax rate will remain at 9.25 mills with 4.75 mills for the general fund, 1.5 mills for the fire department and 3 mills for the dedicated road program.

Due to a rise in power purchase costs, Perkasie residents will see an increase in their electric rate. Perkasie Borough Council passed Ordinance No. 1052, officially increasing the electric rates by 7%. For an average home that uses 1,000 kWh per month, their cost will go from \$140.88 to \$150.88. The rates will go in effect with the February 15, 2023 meter reading which is for electricity used between January 15, 2023 and February 15, 2023.





A message from the Code Enforcement Department

Springtime means growth, which also means it is time to keep an eye on your trees and shrubbery on your property! It is especially important for line of sight around corners to avoid any obstruction for pedestrian and vehicle traffic. Please see the ordinance below and make sure to keep your trees trimmed.



§ 175-3Requirements for trimming trees.

It shall be the duty of the owners of real estate in the Borough of Perkasie to trim and keep trimmed all trees located upon such property and along or near to any street in the Borough, so that:

- A. The limbs and/or branches thereof shall in no way interfere with electric wires and other wires lawfully suspended along such street. There shall be a clearance of at least 10 feet from all electrical wires and utility poles to all branches, limbs, or trunks and any other portion of the tree which may be overhanging any electric wires or utility poles. [Amended 3-6-2017 by Ord. No. 1003]
- B. The limbs and/or branches thereof shall not obscure or obstruct the light from any streetlight.
- C. No part of such tree or the limbs and/or branches and foliage thereof shall obstruct the view of the said street and/or traffic thereon by persons operating vehicles upon such street or any intersecting street.
- D. There shall be a clearance of at least 14 feet from the surface of the street and at least eight feet from the surface of the sidewalk to the lowest branch or limb of such tree or any other overhanging part thereof.
- E. No portion of the trunk of any tree shall encroach horizontally over the roadway of the street or over the paved portion of the sidewalk.
- F. Any tree upon a property which is dead or substantially diseased shall be removed by the owner of the property on or in front of which the same is located in instances where damage to neighboring property and/or Borough property is imminent. [Added 3-6-2017 by Ord. No. 1003]
