# PERKASIE BOROUGH ANNOUNCES RETURN OF UNDER THE STARS CAR SHOW

Perkasie Borough is delighted to announce the return of their annual Under the Stars Car Show, scheduled for 4pm-8pm on Saturday August 21st.

Now in its 22nd year, "Under the Stars" is one of the region's premier car shows. Presented this year by Perkasie Borough in partnership with Perkasie's garages and local businesses, Perkasie's historic downtown streets will play host to over 400 antique, classic and custom vehicles and the show attracts 4,000+ visitors from across the region.


"We're so excited to bring visitors back to the town center for this great event" enthused Aaron Clark, Councilman and head of Borough Council's Economic Development Committee. "We're grateful to everyone who participated in 2020's virtual Car Show, but Perkasie and its small businesses are looking forward to welcoming exhibitors and spectators back to town in 2021".

The Perkasie Historical Society is working with Ragtops & Roadsters to bring "The British are Coming" back as a special feature alongside the main show. Registration for both main show and British show exhibitors is open at www.perkasierec.com. Advance registration costs \$15 and is open until 4pm on August 17th. Day of show registration costs \$20. Exhibitors at the main show are vying for 4 main show trophies, 6 sponsor trophies and 50 Top 50 plaques. Exhibitors at the British show will be presented with one "Best of British" trophy and 3 winner and runner up trophies in 6 vehicle classes. Commemorative dash plaques are included in event goody bags for the first 400 vehicles at the show. There is no fee for spectators at the show.

Visitors to town will find vendors, food trucks, period music and shopping and dining specials from Perkasie's small businesses. #### A message from the Electric Department

#### **Perkasie Borough Tree Work**

An important part of providing reliable electric service for you and your neighbors is clearance between electric wires and trees. To help prevent outages and other related problems the Perkasie Borough Electric Department will schedule tree work as needed at no expense to you.



All trees are trimmed differently depending on their proximity to the line. For example trees directly under lines will either be topped or "V" cut. Those close to the line will be "L" cut and trees 10' or more from lines will be cut at an angle. As well, trees will be cut back enough to allow for three years of growth before needing to be cut again.

However from time to time we do have to cut down a tree. This is due to the type of tree, its condition, and/or location in proximity to our wires. If a tree is found to be a danger to the system and we have the ability to remove it, it will be performed on a first come first service basis. Please note though that we will not remove the stump.

Lastly we will always clean up when finished. Trimmers are fed through a chipper and cleanup of the property is performed at the completion of the tree trimming.

And always consult your local arborist for information and assistant before planting new tress especially near power lines.

# A Message from the Perkasie Borough Police Department 311 S. 9TH STREET PERKASIE, PA 18944 (215) 257-6876

The Perkasie Police Department provides full-time police service to the residents of Perkasie and Sellersville Boroughs with a joint population of almost 13,000 residents. Perkasie Police officers provide a myriad of police services with a staff of 18 full-time police officers including two Detectives and two administrative support staff members.

In addition to traditional police services the department has a certified Child Safety Seat Installation Technician who can install child safety seats for parents with babies and small children. This service can be accessed by contacting the police department at 215-257-6876 and scheduling an appointment.

The department also hosts a prescription drug take back box in our lobby where citizens can safely dispose of unwanted prescription medication. We also encourage our residents to visit our CrimeWatch Web Page at https://bucks.crimewatchpa.com/perkasieboroughpd

The CrimeWatch webpage provides information on recent incidents, arrests, scam alerts and other public information. The CrimeWatch webpage is funded by the Bucks County District Attorney's Office.

Perkasie Borough welcomes Officer Lewis Palmer IV who was hired by Perkasie on May 29,2021. Officer Palmer replaced Officer Anthony Delia who retired from the department on January 31, 2021. Prior to joining Perkasie Borough Officer Palmer worked for the Philadelphia Police Department for 4 ½ years. Perkasie is happy to have him on board!



- The Police Department reminds all residents of the law pertaining to fireworks in Pennsylvania which includes;
- They cannot be ignited or discharged on a public or private property without express permission of the property owner.
- They cannot be discharged from or within a motor vehicle or building.
- They cannot be discharged toward a motor vehicle or building.
- They cannot be discharged within 150 feet of an occupied structure, whether or not a person is actually present.
- They cannot be discharged while the person is under the influence of alcohol, a controlled substance, or another drug.





Perkasie Borough Police Department supports Bucks County Crime Stoppers in participating in the Push Out the Pusher program where you can remain anonymous for reporting drug activity and receive awards of up to \$5,000 if that person is criminally charged and convicted.

#### **Perkasie Planning Commission**



#### A Message from the Public Works Department

#### Please be aware the following Trash Schedule updates for upcoming Holidays:

No Trash, Monday, July 5th – Will be picked up Tuesday, July 6th

No Trash, Monday, September 6th – Will be picked up Tuesday, September 7th



- Wash your car at a car wash. Most car washes reuse the wash water before sending it to a treatment plant. If you want to wash your car at home, wash it on gravel or grass.
- 2) Start composting. Pre-made compost tumblers are a great option for a small yard. Not only does composting reduce waste, but adding compost to your soil helps with stormwater infiltration.
- 3) Only rain should go down storm drains. Make sure not to blow grass clippings into storm drains, and if hosing off your driveway or car, try to send the runoff into a vegetated area.
- 4) Set sprinklers to minimize runoff. Make sure sprinkler heads are adjusted to reduce overspray and only water the minimum amount necessary for the plant.


It is closed Sundays and most holidays.

The Borough Recycling Center, located behind the Perkasie Police Department, at 311 South 9th Street, is for the convenience of **Borough Residents ONLY**. Perkasie Borough staff may ask for identification when you use the Center. There are signs indicating where recyclable materials are to be placed. **No plastic bags, please.** Combine glass, aluminum, tin and plastic (PDE #1-7) containers in the dumpsters that are marked as such and that have metal stairs. Combine newspaper and cardboard and place in the trailer.

Trash and bulky items are not accepted at the Recycling Center. Absolutely NO construction materials, aluminum/plastic siding, window glass, shutters, etc. are accepted at the Recycling Center. No laundry baskets, plastic trash cans, large tin (popcorn) containers, fish tanks, mirrors or other household materials are accepted. As of June 1, 2010 yard waste (NO GRASS CLIPPINGS) will be accepted on the first Saturday of the month 7:30 AM - 3:30 PM. Please use brown paper bags, lawn and leaf bags or bring a container to be dumped when disposing of yard waste. **No plastic bags.** Please call the Borough or check the website for additional information.

# A Reminder to Residents from the Code Enforcement Department





The Borough wants to remind residents of Perkasie Borough Code and the Property Maintenance Code –

Grass or weeds or vegetation should not be permitted to grown over 10 inches in height in livable spaces. Any grass, weeds, or other vegetation growing upon any premises in the Borough in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a nuisance and detrimental to the health, safety, cleanliness and comfit of the inhabitants of the Borough.

Tree limbs, branches, and bushes must be trimmed to a height of 14 feet from the surface of the street and 8 feet from the surface of the sidewalk. The sidewalk should also be clear of any side obstructions and maintain a clear width of 4 feet. These requirements allow for vehicles and pedestrians to have safe access around roads and sidewalks.

All exterior property and premises shall be maintain in a clean, safe, and sanitary condition. The occupant shall keep that part of the exterior property which such occupant occupies or controls in a clean and sanitary condition.

#### PERMITS REQUIRED FOR PAVILION AND FIELD RENTALS

Thinking about having am event or party in one of the Perkasie Borough Parks? Make sure to secure your space with a 2021 Permit! Permit requests are due no later than 45 days in advance and may require Council approval. Do not wait to secure your date – many popular weekend dates book up fast. Please stop by the Borough Hall to get your paperwork submitted. Permit forms are available on www.PerkasieRec.com or you can stop by Borough Hall during business hours. Questions? #### **Reminders for the Perkasie Park System**

- Parks are open from sunrise to sunset.
- Sport fields in the parks are available by permit only. Persons who wish to use the pavilions and fields should apply for permits through the Parks & Recreation Department
- Facilities are available for special events, parties, family picnics and business gatherings, popular dates do fill quickly. Permits are available online at www.PerkasieRec.com
- Please do not feed the wildlife, especially the fox, deer, and geese
- Solicitation by vendors is not permitted in any park
- Motorized vehicles, including dirt bikes and ATVs are not permitted in Borough Parks
- Cyclists must yield to pedestrians on all park trails
- No smoking, alcohol, or illegal substances are permitted in the parks
- No dumping.
- Commemorative benches and tables honoring friends, family, pets and others are available for placement in any Borough Park. For more information please visit www.PerkasieRec.com
- Dogs must be on a leash. If you see a dog running loose, please call the Police
- Pet owners are required to clean up after their animals, not only in Borough Parks, but on all public and private property throughout the Borough or face the possibility of a fine
