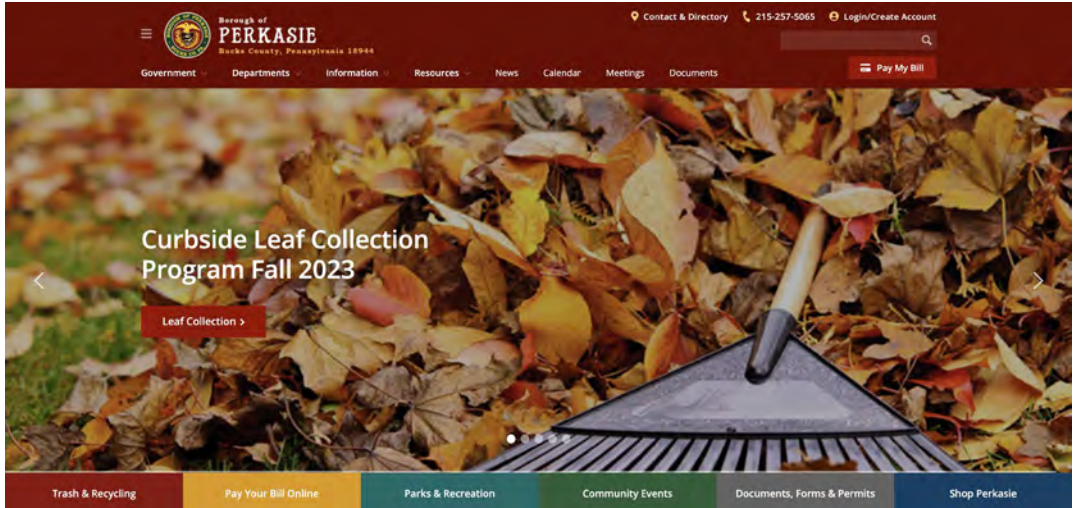


PERKASIE BOROUGH IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE LAUNCH OF OUR UPDATED WEBSITE!

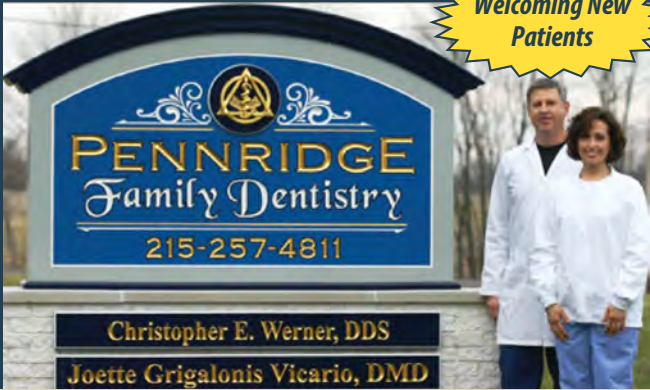

LETTER FROM THE MAYOR

When I read that answer, I thought of a variety of people in our community, and right at the top of that list was our very own Perkasio Fire Company No. 1. This quality group of men and women have chosen to serve others, volunteer their time, and run into danger when others are running away. Their website states: Serving the Perkasio community since 1890 and for many more years to come. We are 100 percent all volunteers who respond 24 hours a day 7 days a week 365 days a year. On average our response time is 3 to 4 minutes. If you see us out and about please stop over and say hello! Thursday nights at 7 PM we hold "Drill" we would love to see you.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

A REMINDER OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR SNOW EVENTS AND EMERGENCIES

To help Borough crews with the removal of snow from streets, the Borough Code of Ordinances restricts parking on some Borough streets when there are three or more inches of snow. The schedule of streets regulated by § 180-18.1 is as follows:

- Hunters Run – east side, entire length
- Parkridge – both sides, entire length
- South Seventh Street – east side, from Borough Hall parking lot entrance to West Chestnut Street
- West Chestnut Street – south side, from South Seventh Street to Borough Hall parking lot exit

Snow Emergency Routes

When there is snow accumulation of three inches or more, the Borough Code of Ordinances prohibits parking on these snow emergency routes.

- Arthur Avenue – both sides, from Elm Street to South Fifth Street
- Callowhill Street – both sides, entire length (except south side only from Fifth Street to Seventh Street)
- Constitution Avenue – both sides, entire length
- Fifth Street – west side, entire length
- Main Street – west side, entire length
- Market Street – south side only, from Fourth Street to Fifth Street

- South Fourth Street – both sides, from Cedar Avenue to Elm Street
- West Blooming Glen Drive – both sides, entire length
- West Park Avenue – both sides, from Fifth Street to Ridge Road (except south side only from Fifth Street to Ninth Street)
- West Walnut Street – north side only, from Seventh Street to Constitution Avenue
- West Market Street – south side, from Ridge Road to Fifth Street

Town Center Clean Up – Parking Restrictions

Perkasie Borough crews work to remove snow from the center of town after a snow storm at night, usually beginning at midnight. The roads will be marked with No Parking signs in advance, if possible. Parking will be restricted for snow removal as follows:

- 7th Street from Arch to Walnut
- Arch Street from 7th to 6th
- Market Street from N. 6th to Railroad
- Chestnut Street from 6th to 7th
- Walnut Street from 5th to 7th
- 6th Street from Market to Walnut
- 7th in front of Electric Department
- Area around Post Office at 7th & Vine Street
- Main Street in area of The Perk

Winter Snow Reminders from the Code Enforcement Department

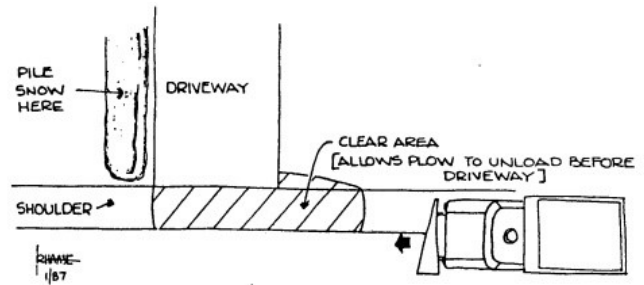
The snow has stopped and now it is time to clear your driveway and sidewalks.


Please do not pile, shovel, or snow blow your snow into the street. Waiting until the plows are done clearing your street before attempting to clear your driveway/parking space. It may take a plow 2 or 3 passes on the road to ensure proper and safe travel lanes.

Cul-de-sacs are the most difficult and time consuming streets to plow. Plowing a cul-de-sac can take up to eight times longer than a through street of the same size because of the limited amount of space to deposit snow without burying driveways, mailboxes, and fire hydrants.

Please do not travel on roads during a snow event unless it is absolutely necessary. Do not use your snowmobiles or all-terrain vehicles on the roadways. Snow plow operators have to concentrate on the roadways with the additional vehicles on them.

Perkasie Borough Ordinance § 152-2 states that all business and commercial premises within the Borough shall remove snow from their sidewalks within 6 hours after the snow, sleet, or freezing rain has stopped. All residents shall have all snow, sleet, or freezing rain removed from their sidewalks within 18 hours after the snow has stopped. For your safety and the safety of others, be sure you make plans to comply.

MELTING SNOW IS STORMWATER TOO!

Stormwater runoff can come in many forms, including snow melt! When the ground is frozen, melting snow can't infiltrate into the soil the way that rain water is able to. This means that even a small amount of snow can cause flooding on your property.

When snow melts, it picks debris and pollutants that make their way into nearby streams and creeks. In the winter, de-icing salts are a main contributor to stormwater pollution, causing detrimental impacts to local wildlife and water quality.

Check out these simple steps that you can take to reduce stormwater runoff on your property this winter!

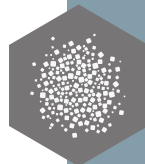

Start shoveling early! The more snow you remove, the less salt you'll need to use.



Pile snow in locations with the most opportunity for it to infiltrate into the ground.



Use de-icing salt sparingly. Follow the product instructions and give it time to work. Sweep up any remaining material.



Clear away any snow that may have been thrown onto storm drains.

Bus Patrol

The Perkasie Borough Police Department is participating in the BusPatrol safety program to reduce the amount of school bus red light violations. The following article, which was posted on the Pennridge School District webpage, explains the program;

The Pennridge School District Empowers The "Bus Patrol" System.

Children who ride to school on Pennridge School Buses and their parents can expect a safer, smarter commute thanks to a new safety initiative. In March, the Pennridge School District agreed to a six-year contract with the BusPatrol organization and local law enforcement to tackle the illegal passing of stopped school buses and utilize better tools for monitoring the safety inside our buses too.

As part of the safety initiative, the entire fleet of 106 buses has been outfitted with automated enforcement technology to detect the license plates of vehicles that fail to stop for school buses, putting children at risk. The video evidence is shared with local law enforcement for review before a citation is issued. The Pennridge School District is partnering with the Pennridge Regional, Hilltown Township, Dublin Borough, and Perkasie Borough Police Departments.

The programs will go live on October 1, 2023, and we invite our community motorists to familiarize themselves with the bus safety laws.

Incoming Pennridge School District Superintendent, Angelo Berrios asserted "I'm pleased to announce that our partnership with 'Bus Patrol,' which we approved last March, will officially go into effect on Monday with the full support of law enforcement. This initiative underscores our unwavering commitment to the safety and security of our students during their daily commute. With 'Bus Patrol' in action, we are taking proactive measures to ensure the highest level of protection for our children. Please take a moment to watch the attached video for a comprehensive understanding of how this collaboration will enhance the safety of our school transportation system."

Last October, Pennsylvania authorities reported more than 250 stop-arm violations in one day during Operation Safe Stop. In 2020, the Allentown School District captured over 200 illegal passings on just two buses over a 47-day stop-arm study. This is equal to 2.18 violations per bus per day.

A spokesperson for BusPatrol, said that the safety initiative is proven to make roads safer: "Every day, thousands of cars ignore school bus stop-arms and speed past school buses as children are stepping on and off. Sadly, this dangerous motorist behavior is only getting worse. Our safety programs combine education

and enforcement to change driver behavior and ensure that all motorists know when to stop for the big yellow bus. In some communities, our programs have reduced the rate of illegal passing by up to 30%." As stated by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, motorists must stop at least 10 feet away from school buses with red lights flashing and stop-arm extended. The penalty for a first-time violation is \$300.

Officer Rob Early Retires

The Police Department congratulates Officer Rob Early on his retirement from our agency which was effective on November 10, 2023. Officer Early served the residents of Perkasie and Sellersville

Boroughs for over 23 years starting his career with Perkasie Police on June 5th of 2000. Officer Early spent his career in patrol and was a member of the Major Incident Response Team, Motor Unit and was a Department Firearms Instructor. Officer Early will be retiring from Perkasie Police to join the newly formed Perkiomen Valley School District Police Department. We wish Officer Early well in his new endeavors!

Message from the Perkasio Electric Department

Add to that the increased use of appliances in the winter – most notably space heaters, electric blankets, and other heating elements – and the potential for dangerous electrical problems only grows.

As noted from the National Fire Prevention Association and Eric Krise Electrical Contractors here are some electrical safety tips for this winter season:

Heating safety tips

- Always keep flammables (including children!) at least three feet away from heaters, stoves, and furnaces.
- Never heat your home using an oven.
- Hire a professional to install stationary heating equipment, such as heaters, water heaters, and central heating.
- Hire a professional to inspect and clean heating equipment and chimneys at least once a year.
- Always keep space heaters in your sight. Never go to sleep with one turned on.
- Be mindful of the fuel you use to power your device; is it recommended by the manufacturer?
- Ensure your fireplace has a sturdy screen in place to keep sparks from entering your home.
- Get into the habit of checking smoke alarms throughout the house at least once a month.

Downed Power Lines

- Never touch a downed line: not with your hand and not with other objects.
- Never touch an object, car, equipment, or even a person who is in contact with a fallen power line.
- If a power line has fallen near your home, alert the children, keep pets away, and notify your township.
- Never drive over a fallen power line.
- If your vehicle does, however, come into contact with a fallen power line, follow these safety steps:
 - Stay put. Do not exit your vehicle; the ground around you may be electrified.
 - Dial 911, blow the horn, or roll down your window to call out for help.
 - Wait for the fire or police departments (or utility worker) to say it's safe for you to exit the vehicle.

Electric Blankets and Heating Pads

- Electric blankets and heating pads should never be used together on a bed.
- Get into the habit of inspecting your electric blanket or pad for flaws or fraying wires before you plug them in.
- Never tuck an electric blanket under a mattress, or cover with another blanket or layer.
- Be sure to follow instructions provided by the manufacturer before plugging in and using your blanket or pad.

Chief Adam will discuss the past and present of the Lenape people in Pennsylvania. This will include pre-colonial life, relationships with William Penn, the era of Penn's Sons and the Walking Purchase, the Lenape diaspora and where they are today, the Lenape who remained in their homeland and how they remained, and what the Lenape Nation of Pennsylvania is doing today to revitalize Lenape culture and continue their role as caretakers of the environment. Discussion and questions from the audience will be welcome and encouraged!

Adam Waterbear DePaul is a Chief of the Lenape Nation of Pennsylvania, where he serves as Tribal Storykeeper and Director of Education. He collaborates with academic institutions on initiatives related to the Lenape people, including land acknowledgements, mascots & representation, programming, and curriculum development. He is a PhD candidate at Temple University and a Scholar-in-Residence at Arcadia University, where he currently teaches classes in Indigenous Studies, World Mythology, and Punk Rock. He co-curates the Lenape Cultural Center in Easton PA and the Lenape "Enduring Presence" exhibit, now travelling from Haverford College to Arcadia.

"Snow plowing of streets and roadways, park service drives, municipal parking lots, sidewalks on Borough-owned properties, and any emergency needs are to take priority over snow removal. However, removal of snow from the designated areas is to be a priority of plowing of snow from municipal bike paths."

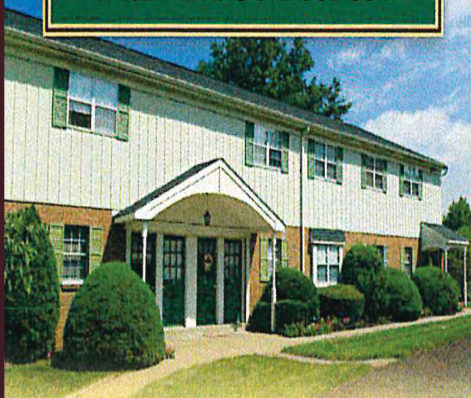

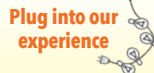
