This contract includes a base bid and three alternate bids for the milling, base repair and paving of specified roadways within Perkasie Borough. The base bid also involves roadway widening, installation of pavement markings, and installation of storm sewer improvements at specified locations. One alternate bid involves the complete reconstruction of a portion of N. 8th Street, while the other alternate bids also involve the milling, base repair and paving of the Borough Police Station Parking Lot along with installation of compliant ADA stalls, pavement markings and storm sewer improvements. All material, labor, and equipment necessary shall be in accordance with PennDOT Publication 408 and Borough Standards. **Asphalt materials shall be based on PennDOT's May 2024 Asphalt Cement Price Index.**
