All Councilmembers voted in favor of awarding the bid, with the exception of Conville who voted against it.

Upon motion by McGonigal, seconded by Hettel, Council considered renting various equipment including dozers and loaders for demolishing the concrete at the Menlo pool.

All Councilmembers voted in favor of filling the vacancy with the exception of Ray Conville who abstained from voting due to a conflict of interest.
