APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Skate Park Update – Information update: Matt reported more kids coming out to meetings. Ten year plan – Rich reported committee is reaching out to local schools for design. Dog Park Update – Tom Bancroft showed newspaper articles on the successful “dog days of summer” water ice fundraiser. Tom explained the pros and cons of three different sites within the borough. The P & R Board was to asked answer several questions.
