

Sellersville Borough

Lenape Park - This 85-acre site is adjacent to Perkasio's Lenape Park and provides over 126 acres of contiguous park land between the two Boroughs. Sellersville's Lenape Park houses a boy scout cabin, picnic areas, a play area, baseball fields, restrooms and parking. Both Lenape Parks accommodate non-motorized boating, fishing, bicycling and hiking.

B. Earl Druckenmiller Playground - The highly developed 7 acre park houses softball fields, a play area, picnic area, restrooms and parking. It can be accessed from the bicycle/walking path by making a right onto Main Street and then a left onto Walnut Street located next to the Sellersville Post Office. As you pass the intersection of Lawn Avenue, the playground is located just beyond on the left.

Holiday House Recreation Area - This 15 acre complex, located on Washington Avenue, is just north of the Sellersville Borough limit and is operated by the West Rockhill-Sellersville Joint Recreation Authority. The site contains a community swimming pool, basketball court, and houses the Pennridge Branch of the Upper Bucks YMCA. This facility can be accessed by car, traveling northwest on Main Street from the bicycle/walking path entrance to Noble Street. Make a left onto Noble and then a right onto Washington Avenue. The facility is situated at the top of the hill on the right.

Perkasie Borough

Lenape Park - The 41 acre park was purchased by the Borough in 1938 and houses a portion of Perkasio's bicycle/walking path. It is also highly developed for recreational use including two Little League fields, picnic areas, ice skating pond, one sand and one grass volleyball court, an historic covered bridge, two pedestrian suspension bridges, two picnic pavilions, restrooms and parking.

Menlo Park - This land was previously used as an amusement park and still houses the carousel from that period. The 3.02 acre site, purchased by the Borough in 1956, is adjacent to Lenape Park separated by a steep wooded slope. Along with the carousel, this park also houses the community pool, local library, two picnic pavilions and a tot lot.

Frank R. Kulp Playground - The 10-acre site is situated adjacent to the bicycle/walking path but separated from the path by the Perkiomen creek. It was conveyed to the Borough in 1964 by the Pennridge School District. Access is available from the bicycle/walking path by using the Market Street bridge. This park houses a lighted baseball field with covered grandstands, 5 lighted tennis courts, a baby pool, 3 lighted basketball courts, tot lot and parking.

Tot Lot on Spruce Street - This recently developed lot can be accessed from the path by traveling across the suspension bridges to Constitution Avenue and then following Spruce Street to the lot. An extension of the path planned for the near future, will connect the tot lot to the remaining park system.

East Rockhill Township

Willard H. Markey Centennial Park - The park, located at 1418 Ridge Road, is known locally for its self-operating driving range with token machines located at the parking lot and in the concession stand. The tokens operate the ball dispenser also found in the concession stand. The range is open seasonally from dawn to dusk.

You will also find a picnic pavilion, child's play area, sand volleyball court, basketball backboard, skate park and fields for football and soccer.

Three Mile Run Road Open Space - Located near the intersection of Schoolhouse Road, this 87-acres of wooded land is preserved for passive recreation and accessible to the public.

Also located in the general area:

Nockamixon State Park - Located ten minutes from the Sellersville-Perkasie-East Rockhill area, is a 5,400 acre state park with an additional 1,450 acre man-made lake. There are overnight facilities available, a swimming pool complex, boat rental concession and a boat marina. There are also picnic areas and bicycle/hiking trails. Bicycles can be rented on site. The park is available for hunting and fishing.

Winter sports can also be enjoyed including, ice skating, fishing, sledding and cross-country skiing.

State Game Lands #139 - 131.2 acres located in East Rockhill is available for hunting.
