#### PERKASIE BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 1002

#### AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PERKASIE, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 46 OF THE PERKASIE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO THE COMMISSION OF THE TAX COLLECTOR

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Borough Code at 8 Pa.C.S.A. § 101 et seq., authorizes the Borough Council of the Borough of Perkasie ("Borough Council") to make and adopt ordinances that are consistent with the constitution and laws of the Commonwealth when necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Borough and the maintenance of peace, good government, health and welfare of the Borough and its citizens;

WHEREAS, after public hearing, the Borough Council deems it to be in the best interest and general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to amend its Code of Ordinances to set the commission and payment of the Borough Tax Collector as specified herein;

WHEREAS, Borough Council, after due consideration of the proposed ordinance at a duly advertised public hearing, has determined that the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Perkasie Borough will be served by this Ordinance amendment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Perkasie, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Perkasie Borough Code of Ordinances shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

- \$46-3.B is amended to authorize the Tax Collector of the Borough of Perkasie to collect
   \$6.00 per tax bill collected or liened, beginning on January 1, 2018.
- 2. §46.3.C(2) is amended to authorize the Tax Collector of the Borough of Perkasie to collect an additional fee of \$10.00 per duplicate billing, beginning on January 1, 2018.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed, it being understood and intended that all ordinances and the Borough Code, such as are not otherwise specifically in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect, the same being reaffirmed hereby.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. The Council of the Borough of Perkasie does hereby reserve the right, from time to time, to adopt modifications of, supplements to, or amendments of this Ordinance, including this provision.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. The failure of the Borough of Perkasie to enforce any provisions of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Borough of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately and be in force from and after its enactment as provided by law.

SECTION 7. Under the authority conferred by the Pennsylvania Borough Code at 8 Pa.C.S.A. § 101 *et seq.*, and other relevant statutory law, the Council of the Borough of Perkasie in the County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania does hereby enact and ordain this Ordinance for the Borough of Perkasie.
