ADDENDUM ONE BID# 2024-09

Commingled Recyclable Materials (picked up and delivered)

Perkasie Borough received a question regarding the composition of the commingled recyclable material. A conversation with our Public Works Director indicates that the majority of the materials are plastics, with some metals and less glass. Based on our research and reading, we believe the mix is probably reflective of the percentages in other similar sized communities across the Commonwealth. Pricing can be based on your experience of the composition in similar clients or communities.

Other Changes:

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Section II Transportation Charge

In order to account for the Borough's cost in transporting the *trash* to the disposal facility, a transportation cost of \$5.75 per mile will be added to each bid. It will be assumed that the Borough will make one-hundred and four (104) round trips to the disposal facility (landfill, transfer station, etc.) per year. For purposes of determining the annual bid price, the Borough will calculate the total cost of disposal (including transportation) for each year as follows:

AMENDED TO READ:

In order to account for the Borough's cost in transporting the *commingled recyclable material* to the disposal facility, a transportation cost of \$5.75 per mile will be added to each bid. It will be assumed that the Borough will make one-hundred and four (104) round trips to the disposal facility (landfill, transfer station, etc.) per year. 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Section III Qualifications

All disposal facilities must be licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources. Any final location that the disposal company takes the *trash* to must also be properly licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources. The successful bidder must comply with all regulations (including disposal sites) in the Bucks County Solid Waste Plan (as approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources).

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Section VI Penalty for Delayed Wait

The Borough is concerned about the time and expense of having to wait at the disposal facility to off load *refuse* material. Accordingly, the successful bidders must agree that each time a Borough truck waits at the disposal facility for more than fifteen (15) minutes, the Borough is to be credited two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) toward the expense of dumping.

AMENDED TO READ:

The Borough is concerned about the time and expense of having to wait at the disposal facility to off load *commingled recyclable* material. Accordingly, the successful bidders must agree that each time a Borough truck waits at the disposal facility for more than fifteen (15) minutes, the Borough is to be credited two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) toward the expense of dumping
