
The Certificate of Excellence in Reliability recognizes utilities that placed in the top 25 percentile of reliability nationwide in 2023, as measured against the U.S. Energy Information Administration's (EIA) data. APPA helps public power systems track outage and restoration data through its eReliability Tracker service and compares the data to national statistics tracked by the EIA. AMP covers the cost of subscription to the eReliability Tracker service for all its Members.



LETTER FROM THE MAYOR

It has been my privilege to be your Mayor for more than 2 years, and I want to take a moment to express my gratitude to each and every member who contributes to the vibrancy and spirit of our town. Thank you for your commitment to making our community a better place through volunteering at local events, supporting our local businesses, or simply being a good neighbor; your contributions do not go unnoticed.

In my previous two articles I have highlighted the efficient, essential, and excellent work of both our Fire and Police Departments, and in that same theme I want to share with you an overview of our Borough Administration including names, titles, and brief job descriptions. This group of people is the heart and soul of what makes this Borough function effectively, and they do their job well. Let me introduce you to our Administration with a brief description of the important roles they provide for this community.

Andrea Coaxum: Borough Manager

Andrea is the Chief Administrative Officer of the Borough. She is responsible to the Borough Council for the proper and efficient administration of the affairs of the Borough. She supervises the activities of each of our municipal departments and recommends candidates for hiring to Borough Council. These are a few of her many responsibilities.

Linda Reid: Assistant Borough Manager & Community Development Manager

Linda reports directly to the Borough Manager. She also provides supervision in Economic & Community Development, Planning & Zoning, Code Enforcement and Property Management. She also writes grants and manages the website, social media and Borough communications.

Lauren Moll: Parks and Recreation Director

Lauren oversees the Borough's park and trail system including the Menlo Aquatics Center. She organizes and runs recreational programs, summer camps and events. She also collaborates with the Events Assistant and Assistant Borough Manager in the planning and "day of" operations for large scale Borough community events such as Fall Fest and Tree Lighting.

Rebecca Deemer: Finance Director

Rebecca oversees the Borough's financial, accounting, and budgetary functions. She prepares the annual budget and supervises the finance staff.

Megan McShane: Executive Assistant

Megan prepares Council meeting packets and Council meeting minutes, assists with updating the Borough website, schedules meetings and appointments, maintains Borough files, ordinances and resolutions, coordinates annual Volunteer Appreciation Night and other employee functions. She is also our Right-to-Know Officer for the Borough.

Heather: Accounts Payable & Accounts Receivable Representative

Heather processes receivable and payable accounts, performs payroll processing and is the Administrator for employee benefits and workers compensation.

Jason: Utility Billing Representative

Jason oversees the administration of the Borough's utilities including billing, accounting, and collection of over 4,000 electric and trash bills.

Cassandra: Zoning Officer & Code Enforcement Administrator

Cassie oversees compliance with zoning regulations by meeting with residents or contractors, reviewing applications and issuing permits. Additionally, she enforces property maintenance regulations by meeting with residents and conducting site visits that may be causing an issue or violation.

Jim: Aquatics Facilities and Program Manager

Jim manages all aspects of the Menlo Aquatics Center including satellite wading pool facility located Kulp Park. This includes all facility operations for the pool and bathhouse as well as employee and patron management, supervision, and safety, and the organization and implementation of all programs and events held at the pool.

RECYCLING CENTER

Located at 311 S. 9TH ST. and open Monday-Friday 7:30a-8:30p and Saturdays 7:30a-4:00p (Closed Sundays and most holidays). Residents must display a Borough hang tag on their car in order to use the recycling center. Staff may request additional proof of residence. Do not lend your hang tag to non-residents.

Prepare your recyclables as you would for curbside recycling. Recycling dumpsters are marked; please make sure to use the correct one. **DO NOT PUT PLASTIC BAGS IN DUMPSTERS.**

SUMMER STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

Summer is here, a time to for relaxing vacations, cookouts with family and friends, and lounging at the beach or by the pool! While the summer months provide us with opportunity recharge our batteries, it's important to remember that even though we go on vacation, stormwater pollution does not!

Heavy rains brought on by summer thunderstorms causes runoff to rush into local waterways, picking up litter, chemicals and other pollutants along the way. Additionally, hot pavement leads to an increase in the temperature of stormwater entering creeks and streams which can be detrimental for aquatic life.

Luckily there are some easy steps that you can take to reduce stormwater pollution on your property this summer!

Water your lawn and garden slowly. Only water your grass and plants when necessary. When watering, do so slowly to reduce runoff. Consider investing in irrigation hoses or gator bags!



Wash your car at a car wash. When you wash your car on your driveway or the street, grease, soap and oil can wash into streams and creeks.



Never dump anything down storm drains. Remember that storm drains empty directly into local waterways without being treated. This means that whatever enters a storm drain will flow into streams and creeks.



Direct downspouts over porous, not paved surfaces. Where possible, direct downspouts into garden beds, your lawn or consider installing a rain barrel.

BEDMINSTER AND PERKASIE POLICE DEPARTMENTS ANNOUNCE CIVILIAN COMMUNITY RELATIONS PROGRAM PARTNERSHIP

The Bedminster Township Police Department and Perkasie Borough Police Department are pleased to announce the expansion of a Police Community Relations program thanks to a \$200,000 grant from the PA Commission on Crime and Delinquency.

This partnership will build upon the Civilian Community Relations Program that was implemented in Bedminster Township and recently completed its first year of service to the community. The program utilizes a Civilian Community Relations Specialist (CCRS) who is an employee of the police department to focus on providing services to crime victims and crime prevention programming. Within the first twelve months of the program in Bedminster, the CCRS provided victim services to 124 individuals. These services include assisting victims of domestic violence, helping senior fraud victims recover lost money, supporting crime victims and their families during investigations, and navigating the court system.

The community relations programming put in place by the CCRS includes educating the community to help them avoid victimization. Examples of this important work included seminars and videos to help seniors avoid common scams, and in-person events with our places of worship and our schools to provide safety information and strengthen the relationships between the police and these members of our community.

This grant will add additional services to the community relations program, including the creation of a L.O.S.S team, the addition of a Chaplain Program, and opportunities for college internships. The L.O.S.S team will work with the CCRS to help families when an unexpected death occurs. The Chaplain Program will be a faith-based option that officers can turn to for support for their well-being or as a resource to refer to individuals who suffer trauma. The college internship program will utilize interns from local colleges to help plan and staff police community relation events.

A Civilian Community Relations Specialist will be employed by the Perkasie Borough Police Department to work with the Bedminster CCRS and the Bedminster-Perkasie Community Relations Program will provide these services to Bedminster Township, along with Perkasie and Sellersville Boroughs. We are thankful for the opportunity to expand and would like to thank the Perkasie Borough Council and Bedminster Township Board of Supervisors for supporting this innovative program. This grant was awarded with the support of PA Senator Coleman and PA Representative Labs. We are hopeful that the Bedminster-Perkasie Community Relations Program will serve as a pilot program for future expansion to bring these valuable services to all Upper Bucks Police Departments.

This program will supplement our Bucks County Co-Responder program which places a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in the field with officers. The Co-Responder covering Perkasie, Sellersville, Hilltown, Dublin, and Bedminster is based out of Perkasie Police Headquarters.

The Co-responder handles calls where a person is in crisis either from a mental health issue or a substance abuse problem. Additionally, the co-responder assists with issues involving the elderly and hoarding.

The Perkasie Borough Police Department Provides full-primary police services to Perkasie and Sellersville Boroughs twenty-four hours a day. The police department is staffed by nineteen full-time police officers which includes two detectives that are supervised by an administrative Sergeant.

The police department administrative office is staffed by two civilian employees, (administrative assistant and a police secretary) Monday through Friday from 8;30 am to 4:30 pm excluding recognized holidays. The department non-emergency number is 215-257-6876. For emergencies, please dial 911.

SUMMER YARD WORK & PROPERTY MAINTENANCE TIPS FROM CODE ENFORCEMENT:


Summer has arrived, bringing warmer weather and the perfect opportunity to spruce up your yard from the endless greenery that has taken over. Follow these tips to ensure a successful yard cleanup:

- 1. Clear Debris: Begin your summer yard maintenance by clearing away any dead leaves, branches, or other debris that you may have missed during your spring cleanup. This not only creates healthier growth but also helps deter pests and diseases. Residents can conveniently drop off yard waste at the Borough Recycling Center situated at 311 South 9th Street. Remember, when dropping of leaves, and yard waste they should be contained in cans or paper bags. Please note that Borough crews will only collect grass clippings on your weekly trash pickup if they are in a Borough trash bag or a regular trash bag within a Borough Trash can.

Know what's below.

Call before you dig.

Maintain Trees and Shrubs: As summer unfolds, it's crucial to monitor the trees and shrubs on your property. Having unhealthy trees and shrubs can pose risks and lead to expensive problems for you and your neighbors. Consider having them inspected to prevent potential hazards. Also, ensuring clear visibility around corners and along sidewalks is vital



- § 175-3 Trimming Trees Requirements: Property owners within the Borough of Perkasie are accountable for trimming all trees on their premises and adjacent streets to uphold the following standards:
- A. Guaranteeing no interference with electric or utility wires, maintaining a minimum clearance of 10 feet from such wires and utility poles.
- B. Ensuring no obstruction of light from any streetlight by tree limbs or branches.
- Avoiding any hindrance to street or traffic visibility caused by the tree, its limbs, branches, or foliage.

- surface and eight feet from the sidewalk to the lowest branches or limbs of trees or any overhanging parts.
- E. Preventing horizontal encroachment of tree trunks over the street roadway or paved sidewalk.
- F. Urgently removing dead or severely diseased trees by property owners, especially if there's a risk of imminent damage to neighboring or Borough property.
- **3. Maintain lawns:** Regular lawn care is essential for maintaining a clean and safe outdoor environment. Not only does

it improve the overall look of your property, but it also helps deter pests and vermin. Perkasie Borough mandates that grass and weeds must be kept below a height of 12 inches and should not emit unpleasant odors or conceal any debris. Additionally, any new greenery you wish to add to your yard should be carefully selected to suit the local climate and soil conditions. Remember to maintain all vegetation

within your property boundaries to comply with regulations and ensure a well-kept appearance.

4. Structure Maintenance: For thorough exterior maintenance, start by inspecting the roof for any missing or damaged shingles, signs of water damage, or areas where pests may have caused harm. Timely addressing of roof issues can prevent leaks and structural damage. Next, clean out gutters and downspouts to ensure proper drainage and prevent water from pooling around the foundation. Check the foundation for cracks or gaps that could lead to water intrusion and structural problems, sealing any found cracks promptly. Inspect the siding for damage or wear such as cracks, warping, or peeling paint, and repair or replace as needed to maintain the home's exterior integrity. Lastly, give attention to the deck or patio by sweeping away debris, cleaning surfaces, and addressing any loose boards or structural issues, applying stain or sealant as necessary for protection against moisture and to extend their lifespan.

D. Maintaining a clearance of at least 14 feet from the street protection against moisture and to extend their lifespan.

STAG ARTISAN COFFEE

We spent time recently chatting with Ryan Bradley, Owner and Head Roaster at **Stag Artisan Coffee.** Stag, Perkasie's newest craft manufacturing company, opened up their new roasting facility in the Perkasie Industries commercial complex on E. Walnut St.

Ryan has been roasting coffee as a hobby for ten years or so, on a very small scale at home in his Fountainville garage, occasionally offering coffee to friends as gifts. As word spread, people started offering to purchase coffee and, when the pandemic hit and Ryan's career in office furniture took a hit, a new business was born. Ryan and his family decided to focus on coffee as a career and, when Stag Artisan Coffee signed up as a vendor at the Perkasie Farmers Market 2 years ago, it quickly became a favorite for the market's weekly customers. Stag had to grow fast as demand totally outgrew his hobby equipment, and his new space on E. Walnut St is now home to a 6kg roaster, meaning he can make 12lbs of coffee in

each batch, always using Fair Trade, Certified Organic beans from all over the world, including Indonesia, South & Central America, Hawaii and Papua New Guinea. It's been a "fun and surprising" journey says Ryan as he reflects on the extraordinary growth of the last couple of years. "I fell in love with the local community at the Perkasie Farmers Market, and I was determined to find a space here. I couldn't be happier with the new location".

Ryan is proud to offer Stag Artisan Coffee every week at the Perkasie Farmers Market, at Papa's Cupcakes and online 24 hours a day. Ryan expects to announce partnerships with additional local businesses soon.
