## **Borough Declares Snow Emergency**

This is to certify that Perkasie Borough declared a snow emergency on January 19, 2025 at 1:00 PM. The emergency will take effect when the snow level reaches three inches of accumulation.

Per Borough Ordinance 180-18.2, it is unlawful to park or abandon your vehicle on any public street or highway in the Borough at any time within 12 hours after a snowstorm of three inches or more has occurred.

## RESTRICTED PARKING WITH 3 OR MORE INCHES OF SNOW

To help Borough crews with the removal of snow from streets, the Borough Code of Ordinances restricts parking on some Borough streets when there are three or more inches of snow. The schedule of streets regulated by § 180-18.1 is as follows:

## SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES

When there is snow accumulation of 3 inches or more, the Borough Code of Ordinances prohibits parking on these snow emergency routes.

Any motor vehicle parked, stalled, incapable of moving under its own power or left unattended upon any public street or highway of the Borough at any time within 12 hours after a snowfall of three inches or more has occurred may be removed or towed away to another location by the Police Department or any person or firm
