PERKASIE BOROUGH RESOLUTION NO. 2025-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF PERKASIE BOROUGH, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AFFIRMING COMPIANCE WITH KEYSTONE GRANT REQUIREMENTS REGARDING PROPERTY OWNERSHIP AND PUBLIC LIBRARY USE.

WHEREAS, the Samuel Pierce branch of Bucks County Free Library is located on property owned by Perkasie Borough and leased to Bucks County for use by the Bucks County Free Library; and

WHEREAS, the Bucks County Free Library has applied for a Keystone Grant in the amount of \$63,952 from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Education for improvements to the Samuel Pierce Library's HVAC system; and

WHEREAS, one of the requirements of the Keystone Grant application is that if the municipality owns the property, the municipality must ensure the undisturbed use of the facility as a public library for fifty (50) years or the useful life of the project to be funded by the grant, whichever is shorter; and

WHEREAS, Perkasie Borough affirms its intention to comply with this requirement

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Perkasie Borough, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, that:

The property located at 491 Arthur Avenue, Perkasie, PA, and known as the Samuel Pierce branch of Bucks County Free Library, shall be used undisturbed as a public library for a period of fifty (50) years or the useful life of the improvements funded by the Keystone Grant, whichever is shorter.
