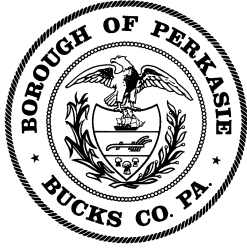

SUBJECT: Steps and Considerations for Reopening the Adopted Budget

Once Borough Council adopts the annual budget by resolution, it becomes the official financial plan for the fiscal year. Should Council wish to reopen the budget, the Borough Code addresses several basic requirements and sets out a timeline.

Per the Borough Code,

Chapter 13, Section 1311: Amending budget and notice:

“During the month of January following a municipal election, the council of a borough may amend the budget and the levy and tax rate to conform with its amended budget. A period of ten days' public inspection at the office of the borough secretary of the proposed amended budget, after notice by the borough secretary to that effect, is published once in a newspaper of general circulation, must intervene between the proposed amended budget and its adoption. An amended budget must be adopted by council **on or before the 15th day of February**”.

In practice, here is what usually happens:

1. At the Mandatory Organization Meeting on January 5th, one council member makes a motion to reopen the budget. The motion requires a second and passes with a majority vote of council.
2. It is essential at this time for the council to select dates and times for special meetings so the budget can be discussed. It is important to note that the newspaper requires a minimum three (3) day lead time to publish public notices. In addition, the Borough Code requires at least three (3) days' public notice prior to a special meeting of Council or its committees. Based on these requirements, the earliest date Council can convene a special meeting is January 15th. One advertisement can list the dates for all the special meetings.

With all of that said, below is a list of target dates that will need to be met to have the final budget approved by February 15th:

Monday, January 5th: Re-Organization meeting where Council votes to re-open the budget.

Tuesday, January 6th: Advertisement for the public meeting schedule must be sent to the newspaper.

Friday, January 9th: The public meeting schedule is advertised.

Thursday, January 15th through Monday, January 26th: TBD public meeting dates and times for budget discussions.

Monday, January 26th: Last date to hold a Special Council meeting to approve the proposed amendments to the budget.

Tuesday, January 27th: Advertisement of the proposed budget must be sent to the newspaper.

Friday, January 30th through Thursday, February 12th: The proposed amended budget is advertised and available for the 10-day public review period.

Sunday, February 15th: Last date to hold a Special Council meeting to adopt the budget.

Wholesale Power Cost Summary

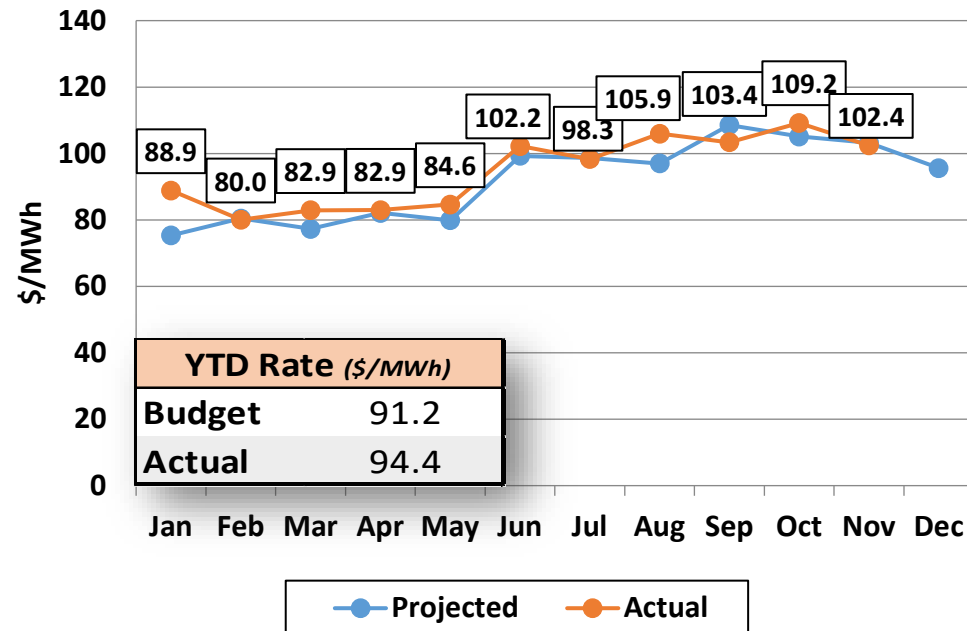

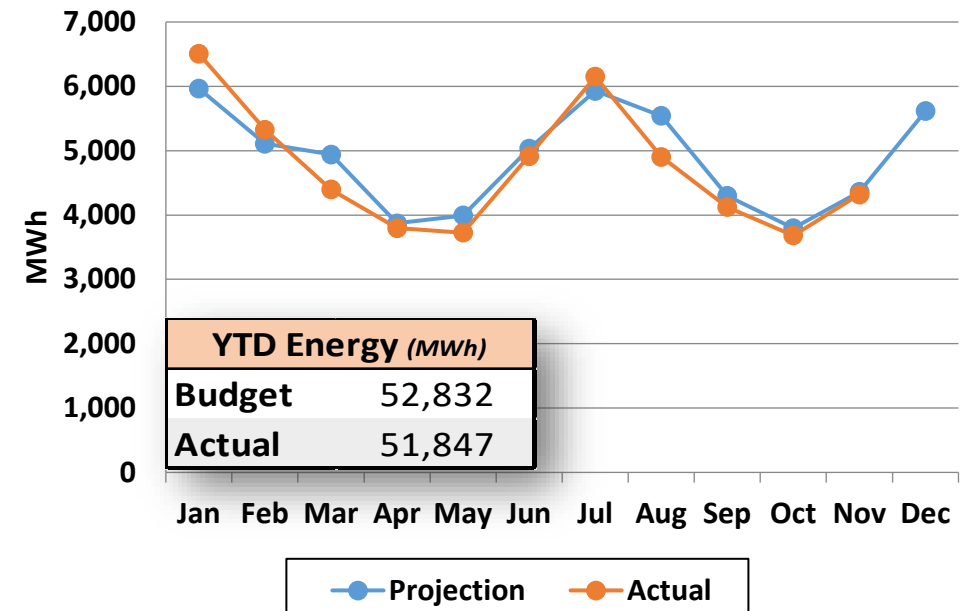


2025 Year to Date Wholesale Power Summary

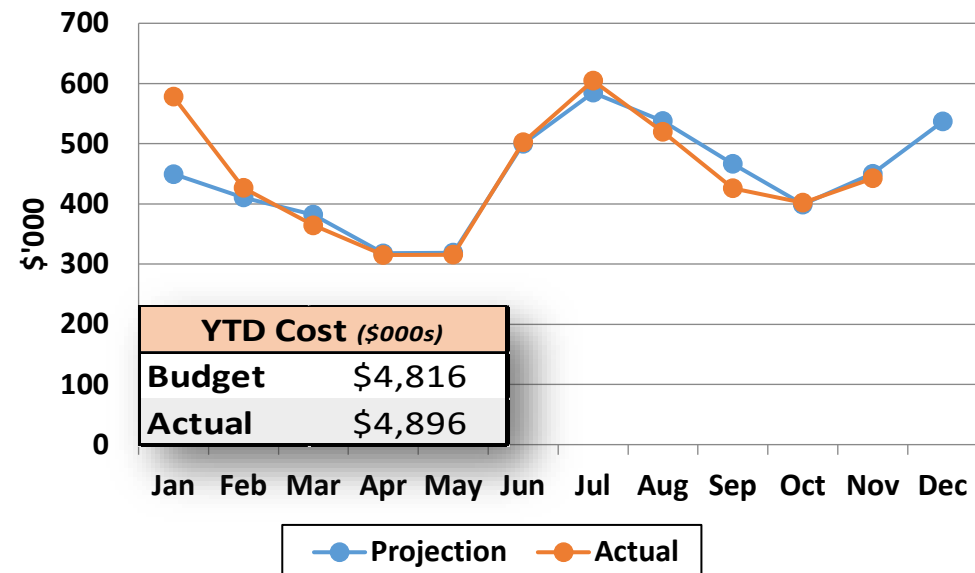
All-in Wholesale Power Rate



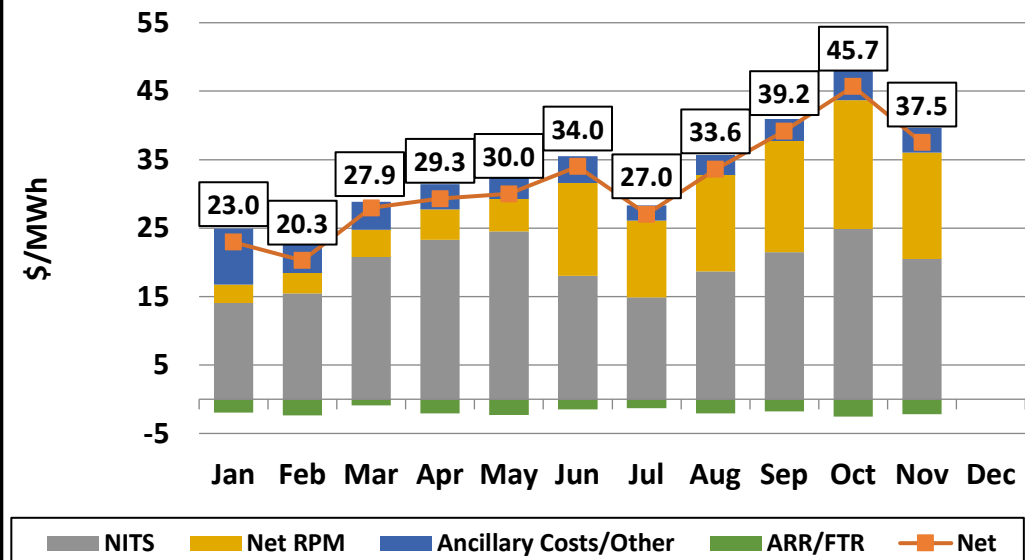
Total Energy Requirements



All-in Wholesale Power Cost



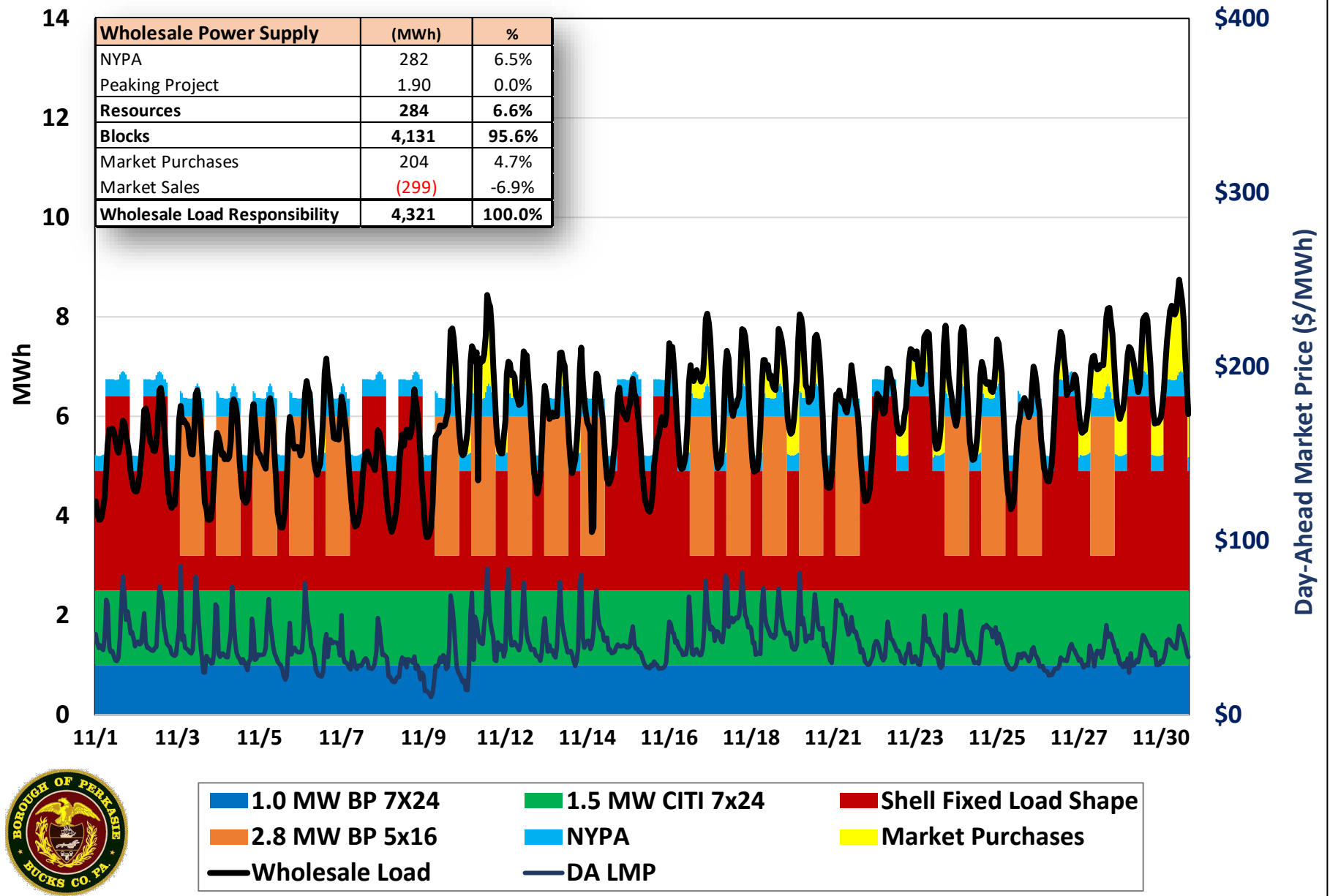
PJM Rates

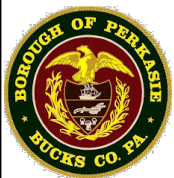

SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Payment of Certain Bills Between Council Meetings

The purpose of the proposed resolution is to allow the Borough to pay certain routine bills between regularly scheduled Council meetings. Specifically, the resolution authorizes payment of payroll and payroll related expenses, utility bills and services provided under contracts already approved by Council. This authority relates solely to the timing of payments, not approval of new expenditures.

The resolution requires any two authorized check signers to approve each payment and that all payments made under this resolution will be listed on a separate register that will be presented to Council for review at the next public meeting. A current list of eligible vendors will also be maintained as part of the Borough's purchasing policy.

Adoption of this resolution will help the Borough avoid late fees, prevent service interruptions and ensure that the Borough is able to take advantage of early payment discounts when available.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PERKASIE BOROUGH COUNCIL ESTABLISHING
PROCEDURES FOR THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN BILLS BETWEEN PUBLIC
MEETINGS, UPON PRIOR APPROVAL BY COUNCIL.**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of Perkasia Borough recognizes that certain routine and recurring obligations of the Borough become due between regularly scheduled public meetings and prior to the approval of Council; and

WHEREAS, failure to pay such obligations in a timely manner may result in late fees, service interruptions, operational disruptions, or the Borough not being able to take advantage of early payment discounts that might be available.

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to authorize the payment of specific categories of bills between public meetings, provided that such expenditures have been previously approved by Council through the adoption of the annual budget, an executed contract, collective bargaining agreement, or other formal Council action; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council further desires to maintain transparency and accountability by identifying vendors eligible for payment between meetings through the Borough's purchasing policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of Perkasia Borough, as follows:

1. Authorization to Pay Certain Bills Between Meetings

Any two (2) approved Borough check signers are hereby authorized to pay the following categories of bills between regularly scheduled public meetings of Borough Council, without the need for additional prior approval at each meeting:

a. Payroll and payroll-related expenses, including wages, salaries, employer payroll taxes, pension contributions, and employee benefits, as authorized by the Borough's adopted budget, personnel policies, collective bargaining agreements, or employment contracts;

b. Utility bills, including but not limited to electric, water, sewer, natural gas, telecommunications, internet, and similar services necessary for the continued operation of Borough facilities and services;

c. Bills for services provided under contracts previously approved by Borough Council, including professional services, maintenance agreements, and other contractual obligations, provided such services are rendered in accordance with the approved contract terms; and

d. Any other routine or recurring operating expenses specifically authorized by Council action and reflected in the approved budget.

2. Vendor Listing in Purchasing Policy

A current list of vendors eligible for payment under this Resolution shall be maintained as part of the Borough's adopted purchasing policy. The vendor list shall be updated periodically by the administration and presented to Borough Council as part of any purchasing policy update or amendment.

3. Reporting Requirement

All bills paid pursuant to this Resolution shall be clearly identified and listed on a separate payment register, distinct from the regular bill list, for ease of identification and review. It shall be presented to Borough Council for review and ratification at the next public meeting of Council.

4. Limitation of Authority

This Resolution shall not authorize the payment of capital expenditures, new contractual obligations, or expenditures not previously approved by Council, unless separately authorized by Council action.

5. Purpose

This Resolution is adopted to ensure the timely payment of Borough obligations while maintaining transparency, accountability, and Council oversight of all Borough expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Prices in biggest US power grid auction hit new record, signaling higher utility bills ahead

- Capacity prices in PJM hit fresh record high
- PJM's supply shortfall affects 13-state region, raising power bills
- Governors push for extended price limits

Dec 17 (Reuters) - Power bills for about a fifth of Americans are expected to continue to rise after the largest U.S. grid operator, PJM Interconnection, reported fresh record-high capacity prices on Wednesday that reflected electricity demand by data centers overtaking supplies.

The expansion of Big Tech's data centers has driven up so-called capacity prices in PJM by about 1,000% over a roughly two-year period, intensifying energy [affordability problems](#) [for](#) those living and working in the 13-state region covered by the grid operator.

Prices reached \$333.44 a megawatt-day in the latest PJM capacity auction.

"This auction leaves no doubt that data centers' demand for electricity continues to far outstrip new supply, and the solution will require concerted action involving PJM, its stakeholders, state and federal partners, and the data center industry itself," said Stu Bresler, who becomes PJM's chief operating officer next month.

Rising costs in PJM have hit everyday power bills in the Mid-Atlantic and Midwest U.S. states in the grid's territory, with some areas seeing a more than 20% jump in utility bills starting from last summer.

Capacity prices make up a portion of utility bills, while other spending on power lines and services and the cost of fuel, such as natural gas, also contribute to the overall cost.

PJM, which operates the grid covering the largest amount of energy-intensive data centers in the world, holds auctions to determine the prices that energy companies will be paid to guarantee they run their power plants when called upon.

On-call generators in PJM's capacity market are meant to guard against disruptions like blackouts during times when power demand spikes, and the high prices are aimed at encouraging developers to build more supply.

More supply, however, is not coming on fast enough. The available supply secured in the latest auction reached 134,479 megawatts. That was about 6,600 megawatts, or enough to power nearly 5 million homes, short of PJM's reliability requirement, PJM officials said.

Higher consumer costs led a group of [PJM-area governors](#), including Pennsylvania Governor Josh Shapiro, to negotiate a price ceiling and floor. That price ceiling took effect during [the last auction](#), in July, and extended through the latest bidding round.

Shapiro and others are now calling for the price limit to be extended to future auctions.

"Reforms must be in place in time to protect Pennsylvania ratepayers before the next (auction)," Shapiro said in a filing this week with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

MORE AUCTIONS

PJM once held its auctions three years out from the time the prices took effect to give power companies time to plan for new developments and to budget ahead of time. With regulatory delays affecting the power grid operator in recent years, capacity auctions have begun to take place less than a year out, which power companies say have slowed the pace of new developments.

PJM is now holding catch-up auctions as a way to get back to its three-year-out program. The prices released on Wednesday will take effect for the year beginning in June 2027.

In the meantime, existing power plant owners in PJM are expected to see windfalls from the recent capacity prices. Independent power producer Talen Energy said on Wednesday it expected to land more than \$1 billion in capacity revenues for the 2027-2028 planning year.

Shares of Talen were up 3.7% after the market closed, while other PJM-region power producers Constellation Energy and Vistra were also higher by 2.7% and 1.6%, respectively.
