The monthly meeting of the Perkasie Parks and Recreation Board was called to order at 7:04 pm on February 19th by Nelson Hollenbach. 2. Public Forum - none
3. Approval of Meeting Minutes: January 15th, motioned by Nelson, seconded by Melissa.
4. Old Business Updates
 - Business Signage on Fencing – Dave did confirm signs are metal. Since we suggested only a six month hanging period metal may not be the best option for smaller businesses. Keeping with the suggestion of vinyl with holes/gromets for fencing.
 - Group discussed the need for a proper drainage pipe for the dog park as the constant wetness is not attractive.
 - LBT Outreach meeting – was held in Quakertown. The feasibility study will be completed in the next few months
 - Bus Trips – the Lancaster and Gettysburg trips were not well received. Another suggestion is a trip for the Renn Faire including ticketing. Also to do another Longwood Gardens Trip in December.

 - Great American Clean up, Saturday, April 20, 9:30 – 11:30 am/ Will be held in Lenape – meeting place at the picnic tables behind the LL fields. Melisa volunteered to head this event. Suggested maps of Lenape to help volunteers with the route.
 - National Trails Day is June 1st, the opening day of the Farmer’s Market. We need a person to help at the borough table to discuss trails in Perkasie – still available.

 - Concerts at Lenape? Not currently, they are just scheduled for Menlo. Once the amphitheater is an option we can move the concerts to Lenape, entrance off Constitution.
 - 5k’s for Perkasie – discussion mentioned that the market is oversaturated with 5ks and they actually cost a lot of money for the timers, approximately \$600
 - Pennridge Little League Fields – the construction seems to have stopped – please provide update
 - Chris suggested he can hold an umpire clinic for interested youth to help train them appropriately for the upcoming season. Program would take place two evenings, one in borough hall, the other at the field.
